

Dear Members of the Cherrywood Leimert Block Club,

Thank you for your participation in the 2018 election process.

Here are the election procedures:

- The election will be on April 21<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Please remember to pay your annual dues. You must be in good standing to vote in April, and to nominate or run for office.
- All offices are open for nominations and there is a two year commitment.
- Eligibility for office. :
- You must be up to date on your dues
- Be in the club for one year, and
- Commit to holding office for two years
- You can nominate, self-nominate or the election committee can suggest a slate of candidates.

Additional nominations will be taken at the March meeting and the nomination process officially closes before the election at the April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2018 meeting.

The Communication Secretary will verify eligibility of nominates, nominees and voters.

At the April meeting, each nominee will have an opportunity to speak for two minutes to advocate for their office. The vote will be taken by written ballots, or if any candidate is running unopposed, vote by acclamation by the club body.

Ballots will be counted during the meeting and results announced by the end of the meeting.

**NOTE: A quorum of 3 club officers and 25 members in good standing is required to hold the vote. The number of ballots that is distributed should match the number of ballots returned and can be used to verify the quorum.**

At the May meeting, the 2018 -2020 officers will be seated.
