

CHERRYWOOD LEIMERT BLOCK CLUB MINUTES – 11/17/18 – APPROVED

The meeting was called to order by President Gwen Jones at 10:20 am.

Officer Aceves of the LAPD attended to fill in for Paul Evleth who is on vacation, and reported on area crime as well as safety measures to take during the holidays.

Holiday Party: Mary Bailey reported on holiday party on December 15.

James Burks of the Vision Theatre reported on the history and renovation of the Vision Theatre, as it relates to the greater community's business and culture. Projected completion date: March 2020.

Membership: Veta Simpson reported that 2019 dues are \$20.

Open forum for community comments:

- Romerol Malveaux spoke about upcoming ordinances to monitor: liquor licenses, home sharing ("AirBNB"), accessory dwelling units.
- Steph Thomas organized a gift donation for kids at Tom Bradley School.

Council district 10 area deputy Albert Lord thanked James Burks for his work on the Vision Theatre, spoke about Taste of Soul (300,000 people attending), reported on other local matters, and took questions
